INTRO MUSIC, up to full volume

2 INT. SPACE SHIP EVENTYR - CHAIKA'S LOG

CHAIKA's quarters.

Beep.

CHAIKA

Personal log.

Beep.

CHAIKA

Solarin, Chaika. Year 2089, month 9, day 24.

Beep. Long beep.

CHAIKA

We are finally approaching Mars. No contact yet, but apparently that's to be expected. I am... I am nervous, but also excited. If all goes well, within a few days, I will... be on Mars. With hopefully some completely new people. I wonder what they'll think of me? Can I... I don't know how to behave around new people.

(slow breath)

Right. So that's very scary... But again, not as scary as there *not* being any new people there... So... Either way. Scary stuff... I did manage to make friends with HYGGE

and LEQU. So I have had some practice now... Practice meeting new people. Making friends...

(small smile)

I... I am feeling better. For real, better. Not less sad, or like the pain has eased, but... Not so overwhelmed. I can breathe, a little, and laugh, sometimes, without feeling like I am betraying her. It's silly, that. My mom loved to joke around, she was always laughing. She made me laugh all the time.

(voice breaks slightly)
I miss that so much.

(small sigh)

Grief just doesn't make sense, sometimes... But seems I am a little better at handling it now. End log.

Beep.

Ding.

3 WORD OF THE DAY

HYGGE

Word of the day.

Ding.

NARRATOR

The word of the day is solace. Solace is English and means comfort or consolation in times of loneliness or distress. It has roots in the Old French solas, meaning joy, pleasure or enjoyment, and the Latin sōlācium, meaning comfort, relief or consolation, derived from the Proto-Indo-European sōlh, meaning mercy or comfort. Related words with the same meaning are the Irish sólás, the Scottish Gaelic sòlas, and the Spanish solaz. The French related word soulas means inebriation.

Ding.

4 INT. SPACE SHIP EVENTYR -

Eventyr control room.

CHAIKA and HYGGE are playing a game.

CHAIKA

(laughing)

No! The green one doesn't go there!

HYGGE

(cheerful)

Really? I think it looks fetching!

CHAIKA

(still laughing a little)

You are very silly!

HYGGE

(happy)

Thanks for noticing!

CHAIKA

(smiles)

Anytime! Now, make your *actual* move.

HYGGE

(mock grumpy)

Oh very well. There.

Beep.

HYGGE

You happy?

CHAIKA

(surprised laugh)

That- You win! Congratulations!

HYGGE

(pleased)

Thank you very much.

CHAIKA

(happy)

OK, that is... fifty-seven wins for you, and exactly *one* for me. Which I suspect you gave me...

HYGGE

(teasing)

Do you really want to know?

CHAIKA

(slight laugh)

No!

(beat)

You are much too clever for me, HYGGE.

HYGGE

(happy)

Just the right amount of clever, I'd say.

CHAIKA

(smiles)

Really? Well, if you say so...

HYGGE

(gently)

So, Chaika, I've been wondering...

CHAIKA

(oblivious)

Wondering what?

HYGGE

(in Danish)

Tilgiv mig... [Forgive me]

(in English)

I don't want to upset you, but I feel I have to ask...

CHAIKA

(slowly, catches on to

mood)

Right.

HYGGE

(carefully)

What do you want to do about the... The large 'package' in storage bay C?

CHAIKA

(confused)

The package- Oh!

(beat, slowly)

The package that is my mother. My mother's body.

HYGGE

Yes.

(beat)

There is ceremonial protocol for space funerals, if that's an option

you are interested in.

CHAIKA

(thinking)

Space funeral?

HYGGE

(serious)

Yes. All through history, humans have enacted ceremonial burials for their dead. For many reasons, religious, hygienic. emotional. In the-

CHAIKA

(not listening)

A funeral. Yeah. Um. Yeah. That would make sense. I never thought about it. I've never... Never lost anyone before.

HYGGE

If you like, I would be happy to make arrangements.

CHAIKA

(thinking)

Yeah. Um.

(beat, direct)

Yes. Please.

HYGGE

For this evening perhaps?

CHAIKA

(thinks, sad)

Why not. Might as well get it done. (thinking)

We'll have to do it before we enter Mars orbit.

HYGGE

My thought exactly. But we could also wait, perhaps on Mars-

CHAIKA

No. No. You were right.

(determined, sad)

Tonight. Tonight'll be good.

HYGGE

I will take care of it.

CHAIKA

(small shaky smile)

Thanks.

HYGGE

Anything special you want me to do?

CHAIKA

No... Might have a poem to read. (wants to stop talking so

she doesn't start crying)

Apart from that, please just set it up?

HYGGE

A poem will be lovely. And will do.

(beat, gently)

What do you want to do now?

CHAIKA

Um.

(lets out breath, sad)

Another round, maybe?

HYGGE

(gently)

Of course.

CHAIKA

(slight smile, sad)

I'll get you this time...

Fade out.

5 INT. MOONBASE - DAY

VALEN

(sighs)

Initiate psychology evaluation.

Beep.

Beep.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Psychology evaluation session enabled.

Beep.

VALEN

(tired)

Solarin, Valen. Year 2071, month 09, day 24.

Beep. Long beep.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
Purpose of evaluation?

VALEN

Um... Post-partum... evaluation?

LEOU

(impersonal mode)

Psychology evaluation to assess patient for signs of post-partum depression and related conditions.

VALEN

Yeah.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Age of infant?

VALEN

Well, she was born August 27, so... Almost a month now.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Exactly four weeks today.

VALEN

(mildly surprised)

Yeah. That's right.

(mutters)

It was a Fourday...

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

What are your feelings now on the pregnancy and birth?

VALEN

(snorts)

It was... You helped... You know what it was like.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

The facts say nothing about your feelings or state of mind.

(beat)

Start with the pregnancy. How do you feel about it now?

VALEN

(sad)

It was... OK. I... It was a little bit like an invasion, you know? Like my body was taken over by this other force, but I'd invited it in, so... So it was OK. Or... it had to be.

(pause)

It was hard.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

And how do you feel about your body now?

VALEN

(another snort)

Well, so far it's just leaking all over the place... Wobbling and leaking... Guess that'll settle down eventually.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
Have you had any thoughts about
harming yourself?

VALEN

No.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
About harming your child?

VALEN

No!

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
How do you feel about your child?

a reer about your enria.

VALEN

(thinks)

I... I want to protect her. From... everything. But also... I don't sleep. She is constantly waking me up and I feel like... I can't think straight. My mind feels... like it is wrapped up in a fleecy blanket... I worry about her. I have to be

everything, to her, up here, and I worry that I will not be enough.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Do you often feel worried or anxious?

VALEN

(thinks)

Often... I don't know.

LEOU

(impersonal mode)

More than once a day?

VALEN

Well, yeah. But then I always have. Guess I'm a worrier by nature.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

So you wouldn't say you are more worried now than you were before you were pregnant?

VALEN

(thinks)

A bit, I guess. But I have so much more to worry about, now.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Describe your feelings about the birth.

VALEN

(lets out breath)

Feelings... I don't know. Glad we both made it through.

(beat)

I *never* want to do that again.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Do you think about it often?

VALEN

(thinks)

No... I try to avoid that. Dream about it, though. That it didn't-

(beat)

That I lost her... That I lost Chaika.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
Have you experienced loss before?

VALEN

(taken aback by the question)

What- I mean, yeah.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
Describe previous loss.

VALEN

(tries to avoid subject) What does that have to do with anything?

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
How you have dealt with previous
trauma affects how you handle this
current situation.

VALEN

(clenches teeth)

Fine. I handled it by applying for this job, and leaving everyone and everything I knew for four years of isolation on the moon. All right?

LEQU

(impersonal mode)
Do you feel that this was a
successful strategy?

VALEN

(angry)

What the [swears] tharp is that supposed to mean?

(beat, calmer)

I'm sorry. Didn't mean to yell at you.

(sighs)

Um. Guess it was successful in that I didn't have to fend off all the well-meaning questions and pitying glances.

(unhappy smile)

On the other hand I suddenly had way too much time to think, so...

(thinks)

Can't run away from your feelings, can you? They catch up eventually...

Even on the moon.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Do you feel like you have processed this loss?

VALEN

A bit. But you're never *done*, are you? It still hurts. A lot.

Baby starts crying in background.

VALEN

(deep breath, frustrated)
Sorry! I need to get her. Can we continue later?

VALEN gets up, footsteps.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Session saved. Return to session within seven days to retain evaluation status.

LEQU generic exit beep.

VALEN

(distant)

Shh, shh, it's all right... Shh...

FADE OUT.

7 INT. SPACE SHIP EVENTYR - EVENING

Distant whoosh of outer doors opening. Distant mechanical sounds as coffin capsule is ejected.

Solemn MUSIC starts.

Eventyr control room.

CHAIKA

(softly)

Where...?

(contained sob)

There...

(breath catches)

There she is... floating away...

LEQU

(gently)

I bear witness to the life of Valen Solarin. Born on planet earth, in the city of Chicago, in the region then called North America, in earth year 2036. Human. The first earth woman on Luna.

HYGGE

(gently)

I bear witness to the death of Valen Solarin. Died on Luna, on moonbase 1-2--2-1--1-4 [one-two--two-one-one-four], in earth year 2089. Engineer. Pioneer. Parent of Chaika.

LEQU & HYGGE

(together, slowly)

We bear witness to a life, and a death. Valen Solarin will not be forgotten.

CHAIKA

(slowly)

There is no happiness or strife. There is only death and life. (quietly emotional)

I love you, mom.

MUSIC volume up, then down.

Subtle LEQU exit pop and HYGGE exit beep.

CHAIKA

(emotional)

Thank you both so much.

Pause. MUSIC fades out.

CHAIKA

(softly, a little

confused)

LEQU? Where did you go?

LEQU generic entry beep.

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

This is LEQU. Psychology evaluation unit. How can I assist?

CHAIKA

(confused)

What? You- Assist?

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Repeat. How can I assist?

CHAIKA

(stressed)

What? Where did you go?

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Unable to process query. Please restate.

CHAIKA

You were here just now, your physical form!

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

Physical form unavailable for this unit.

CHAIKA

You don't- You don't understand, you're not *you*-(calls) HYGGE! Help!

HYGGE generic entry beep.

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

This is HYGGE. Main operating system interface for Eventyr 2-4-6-0-1.

CHAIKA

(panicking)

What is going on? Why are you-

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

You appear to be in some distress. How can I assist?

CHAIKA

(shouts)

What the [swears] tharp happened to you both?

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

You appear to be in severe distress. Do you require medical intervention?

CHAIKA

(shouts)

No! I don't understand-

Distant mechanical sounds as ship adjusts course.

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

New course confirmed. Trajectory adjustment commencing for gravity assist. Destination R-A-179-56-39-D-plus-0-2-46. [R--A-one hundred and seventy-nine--fifty-six--thirty-nine--D--plus-oh--two--forty-six]

CHAIKA

(shocked)

What? But we're almost there- We've almost reached Mars-

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

Expected arrival in 33 days, 15 hours and 37 seconds.

Beep.

CHAIKA

Arrival where?

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

R-A-179-56-39-D-plus-0-2-46. [R--A-one hundred and seventy-nine--fifty-six--thirty-nine--D--plus-oh--two-forty-six]

CHAIKA

(incredulous)

That's not Mars.

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

Correct. Designation Tellus.

CHAIKA

Back to earth? Why? There's no-one there!

(beat)

Override! Set course for original destination!

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

Input override code.

CHAIKA

Eh... Override. Solarin, Chaika.

Um...

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)

Override code not recognized.

(beat)

Input override code.

CHAIKA

(frustrated)

I don't know the code!

(sighs, softer)

What- What happened to you two?

LEQU

(impersonal mode)

You appear to be in a delusional state. Medical intervention recommended.

CHAIKA

No!

(beat, slow and sad)
I just- I don't understand what is
going on. You are-

(slowly, trying to

understand)

Just like the AIs I grew up with on the moonbase, no... There's no *you* there...

(direct)

Who gave the order for this new destination?

HYGGE

(impersonal mode)
CosmiCorps Central Command.

CHAIKA

(shocked)

What?

Fade out.
